The project will collaborate with the state and district administration for enhanced scheme implementation, build capacities, and design and implement innovative pilots. The intervention will influence and aim to improve three adolescent health outcomes among school-going boys and girls in selected districts of UP.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Increase knowledge on gender, reproductive health, and ways of maintaining good mental and physical health. 2. Improving compliance with Weekly Iron & Folic Acid supplementation (WIFS) and deworming to contribute towards anemia reduction. 3. Improve access to mental health services.

She/he/they will be responsible for conducting training programs at various levels, and facilitating the adoption of innovative practices in adolescent health.
